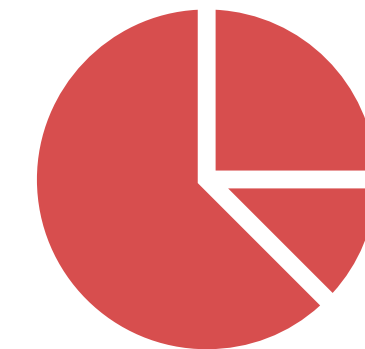
Duty to minimize adverse environmental impacts and promote climate friendly solutions



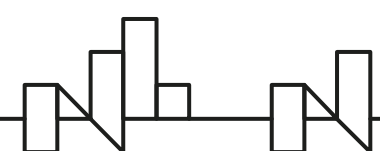
Demands routines to ensure compliance with basic human rights



Freedom to implement ESG-criteria and requirements throughout all stages of the procurement process

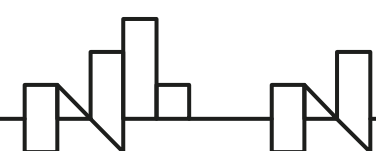
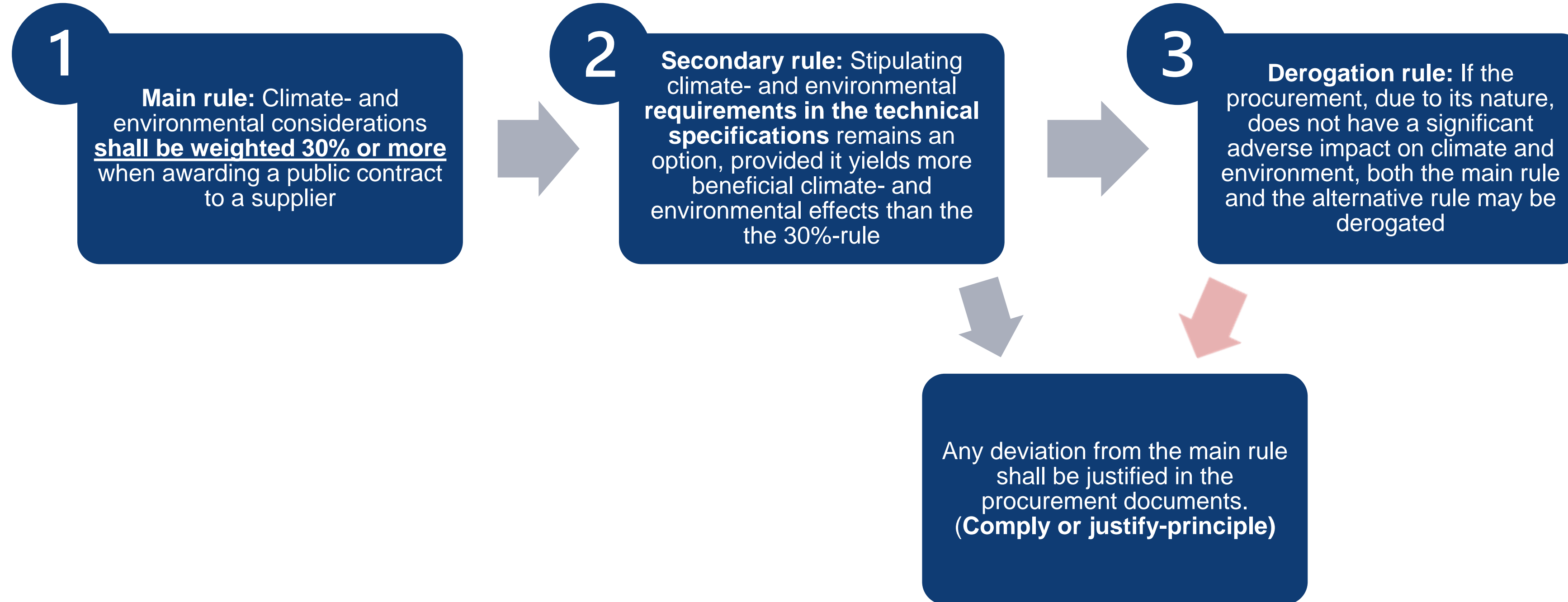


Encouragement to use environment as award criteria and weigh it at least 30%



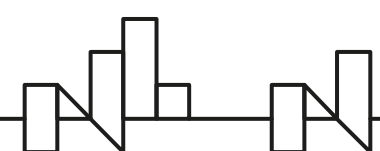
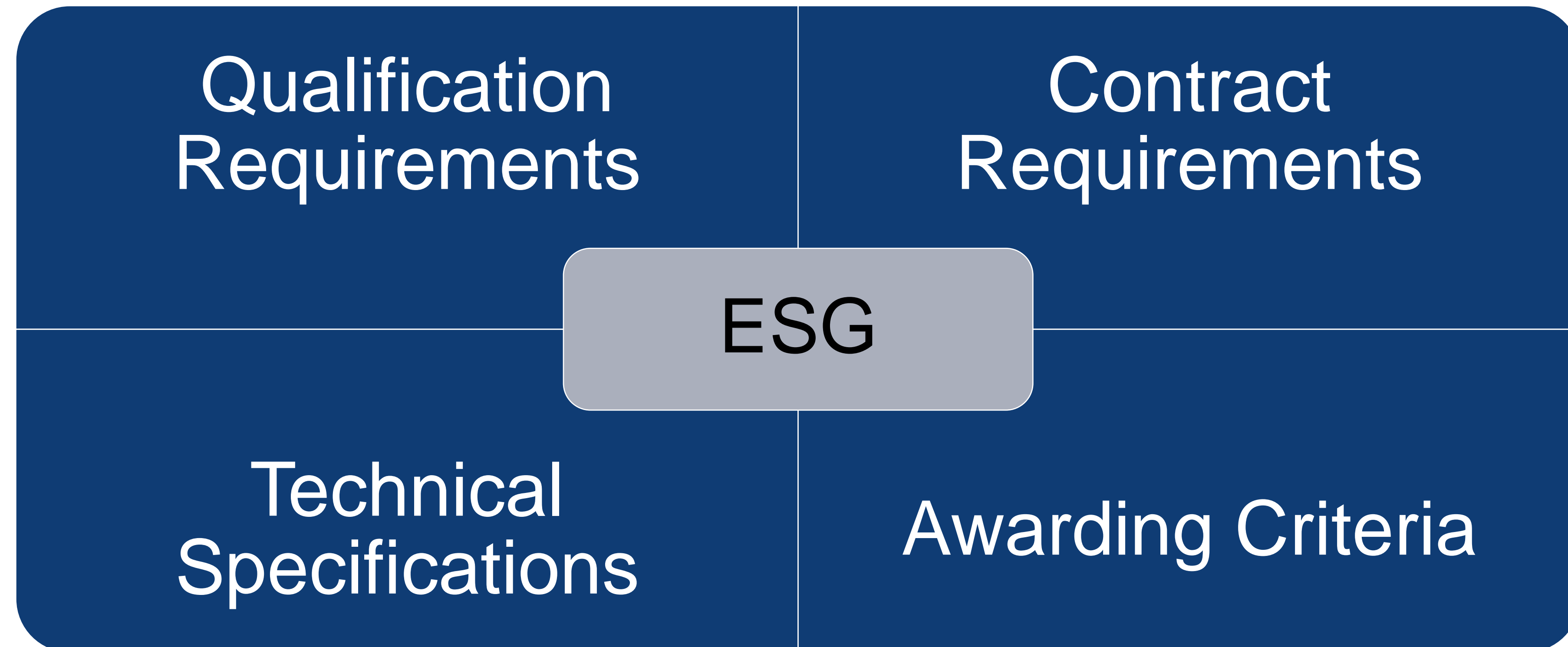

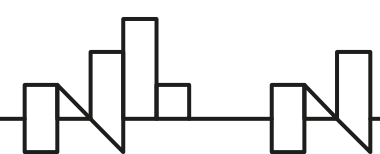
